HOTEL INFORMATION

We will be staying at the Red Lion Inn Hotel, 1850 S Harbor Blvd Anaheim, CA 92802 (714) 750-2801. Since the hotel is within walking distance to Disney, we will walk to/from Disney except on the morning of our performance, at which time we will unload/load instruments from bus after orchestra has performed.

TRIP PURPOSE

This is a wonderful performance opportunity for our Coronado musicians. We are given the opportunity to perform as professionals in a setting that is exciting and memorable. Students spend time and energy preparing the music and presentation and will perform in front of an audience in the Disneyland Theme park. Our performance aligns with Coronado's school site, Scottsdale Unified School District and Arizona State Standards of strand 1, concept 1: Students will demonstrate proficiency by singing with others, music from various genres and diverse cultures. PO 101- PO 415.

ATTIRE

Day 1:

Students need to wear casual, comfortable clothes for travel. We will be stopping at Blythe, CA for lunch and then proceeding to Queen Mary ship tour, followed by hotel check-in. Dress accordingly. Dinner dress is nice, casual. We will be eating at a restaurant in Downtown Disney.

Day 2:

Students will wear Orchestra/Choir T-shirts for the day. Blue jeans only for performance, but you may feel free to change into shorts after performance for the remainder of the day. Regarding appropriateness, only wear shorts that would pass our school's code for attire.

Day 3:

Students will wear Orchestra/Choir t-shirts for the day. Shorts are fine.

PACKING

Items to bring:

Spending money. My guess is to bring around \$60 + dollars. You will need to budget for 2 dinners, 3 lunches and shopping for Dr. Brauer... OH! I mean, shopping. Bring in small containers: toiletry pac, sunscreen, changes of clothes, sleepwear, comfortable shoes, i-pod/book for travel, camera (opt.), snacks (opt.).

Items NOT to bring:

NO drugs, alcohol, weaponry or anything that could be remotely considered these items. Anything of value (expensive jewelry, computers, etc), No drinks with pop-off lids.

CHAPERONE INFORMATION

Your child will have a chaperone assigned to him/her. They will function as help, support, and provide anything students may need. All chaperones have completed a background check, video training and filled out volunteer forms. They have been approved by Scottsdale Unified School District. The chaperones take their job seriously and will maintain to provide your child a safe, memorable and successful performance tour.

As these parents have gone to great lengths to pay for their own trip and received the approval of SUSD, we remind parents that there will be no "tag-along" parents or siblings. Only those who have been approved by the district are allowed to attend. This will keep any confusion and misunderstandings to a minimum.

Your child will be given the name of their chaperone and cell phone number. Please feel free to put their name and number in your phone.

Trip Behavior Expectations

You represent Coronado High School as well as your family and community. Your behavior (attitude, respect, dress code, etc.) will be conducted as if you were attending a regular school day. Your conduct reflects your character and you should want others to think highly of you.

Additional behaviors:

No gum, liquids without screw-top lids allowed on the bus. NO perfumes, colognes or fume-infusing items. You may take snacks but you are required to keep trash picked up and off the floor at all times. Remember, the bus is our classroom as well as our transportation for 3 days.

You must abide by the wishes of your director, Dr. Brauer and your assigned chaperones. This is from the time we leave to the time we return. Be responsible, watch out for each other. Be proactive about dropping and/or leaving items. Watch your money and keep it in a safe place.

Stay in your group while at Disneyland. You cannot wonder away or be alone for any reason.

You may rent a locker at Disneyland and are encouraged to buddy up and share one.

Be respectful to the bus driver. He/she has a serious job and we want them to be able to focus on driving without distractions. Keep quiet on the bus. No loud yelling shouting, laughing, etc. Whatever you bring on the bus, you must take off the bus.

Let's stay happy, focused, show kindness to one another, be respectful to teacher, chaperones and others at all times. Above all, HAVE FUN!

Hotel Information

- Four persons in each room (Quad occupancy)
- Everyone goes to bed at the designated "lights out" time.
- NO ONE will leave their rooms for any reason after curfew time. If someone leaves the room, then everyone sharing that room faces consequences. Your doors will be taped from curfew time to early morning wakeup time.
- Keep in mind that there are other guests in the hotel. There will be no tolerance for excessive noise, such as yelling, loud TV's, music, etc.
- Any damage to a room will be paid for by the occupants of said room.
- No hazing incidents or mistreatment of others AT ALL. If the chaperone or director receives a complaint about any type of mistreatment of others in any way, you will be removed from that room, parents will be notified, and you will be banned from all future activities on the tour.
- If you are guilty of instigating and/or participating in a hazing incident (defined in the SUSD code of conduct), you will be removed from the tour, sent back to Phoenix via airplane (parent's expense) and face a meeting with principal, officers, and parents. The size and breadth of discipline will then be decided.
- There will be a curfew time for each evening. All occupants must be in their assigned room, doors closed and locked. If you have an emergency, call your chaperone or Dr. Brauer and we will go to you. DO NOT open your door after curfew!
- Girls and guys cannot be in the same room for any reason. Visitations can take place in the hall or down in the lobby of the hotel, but PRIOR to curfew and with your chaperone's knowledge.
- Only the occupants of the room (assigned), chaperones and directors can be in a room.
- You are not allowed to leave your hotel for any reason without your chaperone. No one is to go outside unescorted for any reason. If you leave the hotel unescorted, you will be banned from the next group activity.
